

Having had our classroom painted over the Easter holidays, we are enjoying a fresh and inviting new space to learn in. This means that all our displayed work is looking even better! We have had the great opportunity to learn about **Castles** and we have been working on writing imaginative stories using Castles as our setting and exploring characters that might be found in stories with them in, such as knights, dragons and princesses! In our topic work, an exciting part has definitely been the trip we had to **Neidpath Castle** in Peebles. We got to explore the rooms of the castle that's over seven hundred years old and even saw the spooky dungeon which had a trap door from the guard's room! The children were very well behaved during their visit and staff at Neidpath Castle were most impressed! For Numeracy, we are now working on our number work as well as beginning fractions. You could help us at home by using key
